(Requires partial down payment, payments will be debited June - August, on the 5th of each month, until balance is paid)

- No interest is charged
- There is a \$25 enrollment fee per semester (not per course)
- Payment method is by automatic bank payment (ACH) or automatic Credit/Debit card charge
